He makes a total that is more than three pounds but less than six pounds.

How many amounts can he make?

How much money could Jack have?
Is there only one answer?

Jack could have anything from £5.35 to £5.42
Children may record this as 535 p to 542 p

What would you rather have, five 50p coins or twelve 20p coins?
Explain your answer fully.



I would rather have five 50 p coins because $50 \times 5 = 250\text{p}$ but $20 \times 12 = 240\text{p}$
