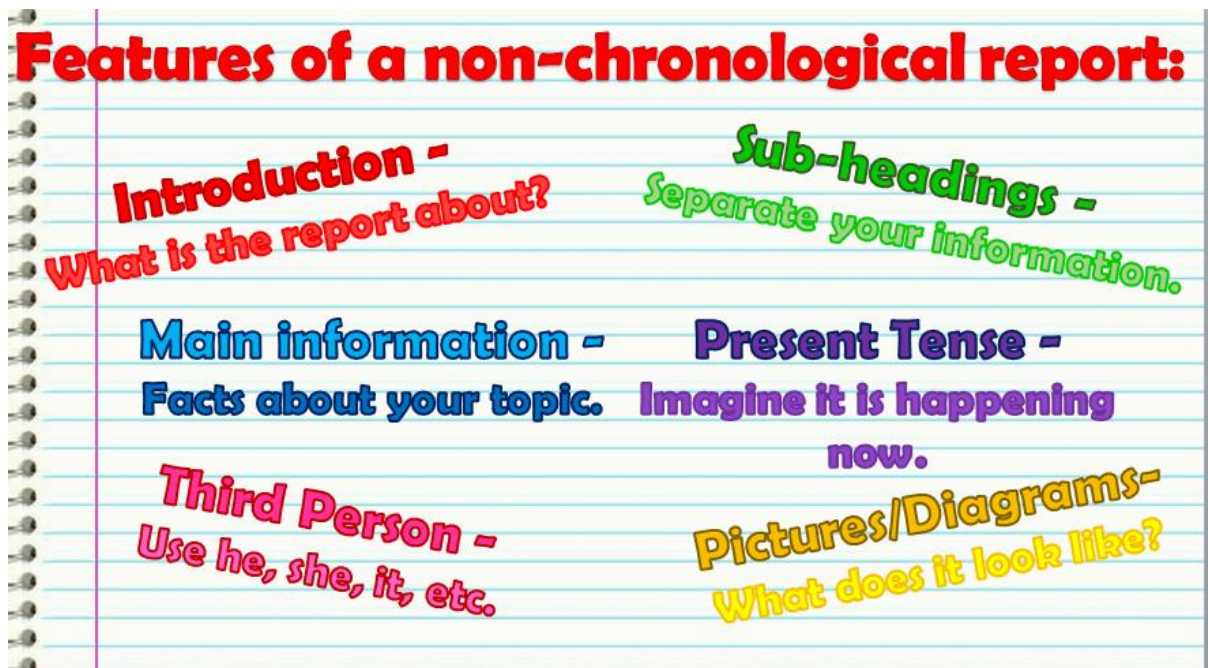


## Writing a non - chronological report

A non - chronological report is a non-fiction text which provides information about a given subject. It does not need to be written in a time order. It does need to be factual and organised into suitable subheadings.



In order to write a report, we would like you to research your chosen sea creature.

You might want to find out:

What it looks like

Where it lives

What it eats

Is it a predator or a consumer

Is it endangered?
