

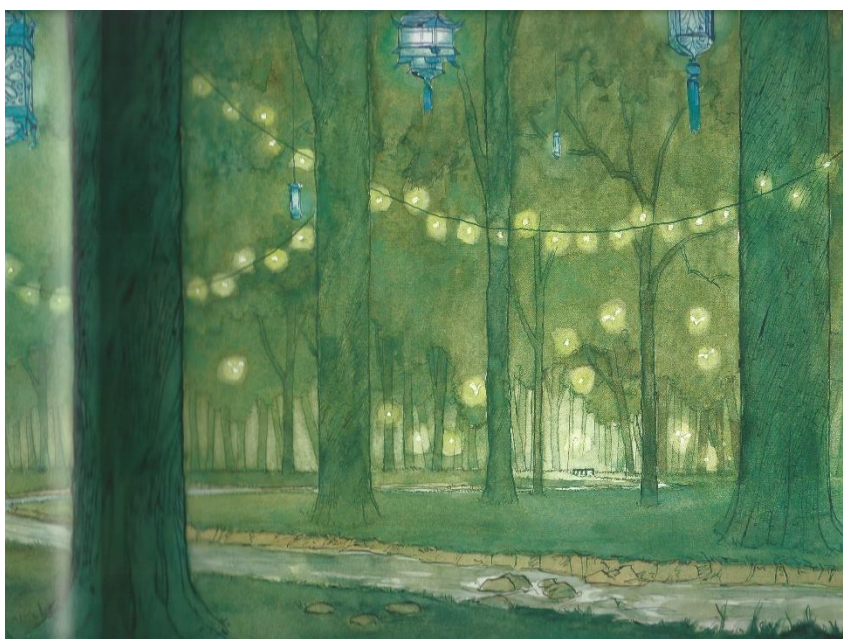
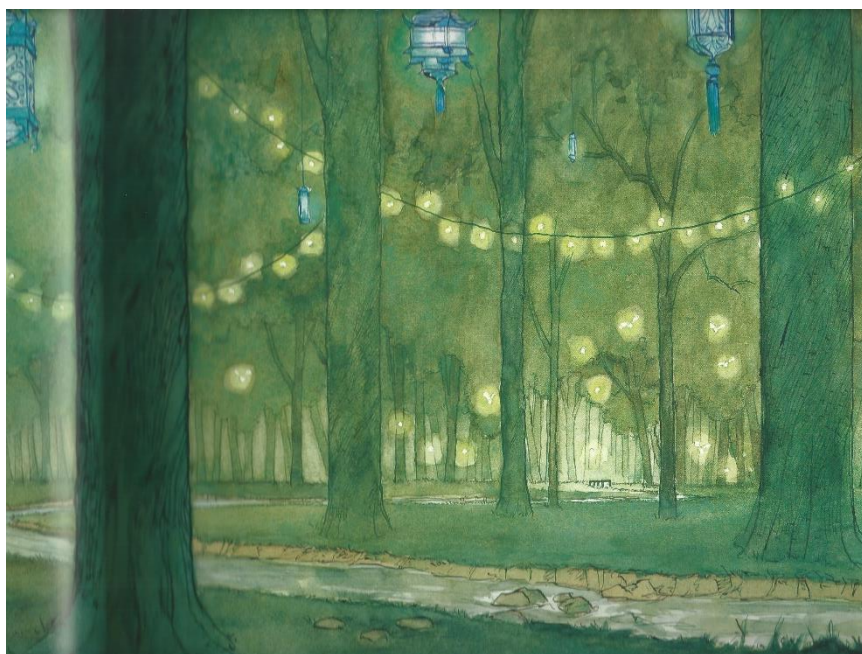
Last week we saw our character escape through the door in the wall.
