The film- maker has lost the script and the actors don't know what words to say.

Your job today is to write a script for the actors.

When writing a play script, you do not need to use inverted commas.

Who is speaking is shown in the following way:

Fred : Hello, how are you today?

Jack: I'm good thank you

You can use adverbs to show how they are saying the words. These are put in brackets to show the actor that he doesn't need to say them.

Fred : (cheerily) Hello, how are you today?

Jack: I'm good thank you

You can also add direction as to what the actor should do as they speak. These are also written in brackets so that the actor does not say them.

Fred : (cheerily) Hello, how are you today?

Jack: I'm good thank you. (walking towards Fred)
