Use the link to listen to the number songs, this should help you revise upto 70. Can you spot a pattern in how to form numbers in the 80s and 90s?

Have a look at the helpsheet, were you right about the higher numbers?

70s – in French we use 60 + the remainder

71 = soixante-onze ( 60+11)

79 = soixante-dix-neuf (60+19)

80s – in French we say 4x 20 = quatre-vingts

82 quatre-vingt-deux ( 4x20+2)

90s- the same as 80s but adding the remainder on

94 – quatre-vingt-quatorze (4x20+14)
