

Revise counting in 2s and 10's



Today we would like the children to revise counting in 2s and 10s.

Counting in 2s

First, play this clip to help your child learn the rote sequence: "2, 4, 6, 8, 10, 12, 14, 16, 18, 20".

Finally, support your child to begin grouping a collection of objects into groups of 2 and then counting them in 2's to find the total. Here are some ideas for how to do this:

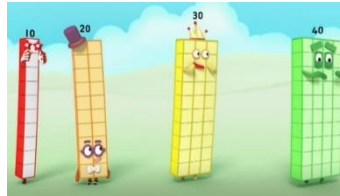
Using objects e.g. toy cars, pasta, buttons: Support your child to count them into little separate groups of 2. Then support them to count them in 2's, writing a little label for each group as they count: 2...4...6... Maybe you could use pairs of socks?
