

This week we are reading and writing words that start with

CCC

These words start with three consonants that you need to blend. This is sometimes a bit tricky.

The red letters are the vowels.

The blue letters are consonants.

Ask your child to name each picture below and then use their robot arms to segment to spell them e.g. They would say “s-c-r-a-p” and then write the word ‘scrap’.
